REGULATIONS

1. Exhibitors are to arrive between 6.30am – 9.30 am in order to minimise vehicle movements on Site, to be in accordance with the Health & Safety Regulations and our Indemnity Insurance requirements.
2. Arrivals after 9.30am will be directed to the Public Car Park and subject to Public entrance fees.
3. In return for a free exhibition entry to the event, you are asked to leave your vehicle exhibit on display until at least **4.00pm**. In the event of an emergency you must contact a Marshal before moving your vehicle.
4. Please complete and return the above form, together with a C5 size, stamped addressed envelope for return of your entry pass.
5. You can only use your issued entry pass for the exhibit registered on the form.
6. The vehicle you register must be at least 25 years old, i.e. registered before June 1994. Proof may be required.
7. This is a one-day event (Sunday 6.30am – 4.00pm) No entry will be allowed after 9.30am or at any other time. Site services and facilities are only available during these hours.
8. We reserve the right to move unattended vehicles if necessary for safety reasons.
9. ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1988 (As amended by the Road Traffic Act 1991) SECTION 13A.

From July 1st 1992 the offence of dangerous, careless and inconsiderate driving of a mechanically propelled vehicle on a road also applies to a public place (i.e. car shows). All vehicles must be road taxed and insured for at least third party. Participating under the influence of alcohol or drugs is strictly forbidden. The Classic Vehicle Show & Autojumble began in a small way over 33 years ago. After out-growing various sites in the Havant area, the Club moved to its present venue at Queen Elizabeth Country Park in 1992.

In recent years it has greatly expanded the vehicle rally by inviting various other clubs to take part, and we are hoping that this year's show will be the biggest yet.

We look forward to you joining us on what we expect will be a memorable day.

On site facilities include public address, catering, a bar, family entertainment and toilets, as well as unlimited free public car parking.
